

Cultural Events

Documents to be submitted with the visa application:

- A visa application form correctly completed and signed
- Two (2) recent color photographs (3 cm × 4 cm) bearing the true likeness to the applicant
- International Passport (including photocopies, only pages containing any information). The passport should be valid for at least three (3) months after the expiry of the validity period of the visa and contain at least two (2) free pages
 - In case of a new passport, photocopies of the old passport are required
- Internal Passport (including photocopies, only pages containing any information)
- Invitation from a Host Entity or Proof of Participation in Cultural Event, written on an official letterhead of the company (with address and telephone number), mentioning the full data of the applicant and signed by an official representative of the Host Entity.
- Certificate of Employment / Membership in a Cultural Group / Organization
- Travel Insurance Policy [The Travel Insurance should be an International Medical Insurance valid for all Schengen countries. The Insurance coverage should be at least 30,000 Euros or equivalent and cover all risks (e.g. accident, illness, medical emergency evacuation etc)]

Important

1. FOR CHILDREN: A Birth Certificate is needed along with a supporting document from school (if the child is in school)
 - When the child is not travelling with either parents, or the validity period of the visa is different for the child and one of the travelling parents, a notary public form of the non travelling parent is required along with a copy of his passport.
If the child is being accompanied by another person, and not the parent, a notary public form from both parents is being required along with copies of their internal passports.
- In case if a child has ONLY one parent one of the following proofs should be presented:
- Form N.25
 - Decision of the court stating that one of the parents was deprived of his/her parent's rights.
 - Death Certificate

2. FOR CHILDREN IN PARENTS' PASSPORT: Visa can only be issued in the parents' name +1X and no individual visa for the child can be issued. In this case a paragraph N.42 of an Application form should be filled in and one photo of the child should be placed on the front page of an Application form to the right from his/her parent's photo.
3. FOR NON RUSSIAN CITIZENS: A valid resident permit for the Russian Federation valid three (3) months after the expiry of the visa is required
4. APPLICATIONS SHOULD AS A RULE, BE SUBMITTED BY THE APPLICANT. IN SPECIAL CASES (DISTANCE etc) THEY COULD BE SUBMITTED BY ANY OTHER PERSON HAVING A SPECIAL POWER OF ATTORNEY. THE CONSULATE MAY AT ANY TIME REQUEST THE PRESENCE OF THE APPLICANT FOR AN INTERVIEW AS WELL AS REQUEST ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS
